ATTACHMENT Port Circular No.01/2017

Terms & Conditions:

- 1. Each licence is valid for 5 years.
- 2. The holder of this licence shall adhere to Port Authorities Act 1963 and its By-Laws, Ports (Privatization) Act 1990, Merchant Shipping Ordinance 1952 and its Amendments, the Privatisation Agreement between the Port Operator and Government of Malaysia and any relevant laws and regulation enforced by the authorities from time to time.
- 3. This licence is only valid within Kuantan Port Limit or Kemaman Port Limit respectively.
- 4. This licence is only valid for pilot who is an employee of the effective Licensed Port Operator.
- 5. Minimum 10 berthing and 10 sailing movements per month are required to maintain the validity of the licence. Failing to comply with the minimum movement requirement within 6 consecutive months shall result in temporary suspension of the licence.
- 6. This licence shall be automatically suspended if the pilot involves in work related incident, accident, offense and misconduct until investigation by competent authority has been conducted and is subject to discretion of the Port Authority for licence recommissioning.
- 7. This licence shall be suspended if the pilot has been impaired in health or his/her fitness has been compromised due to disease or other causes until he/she is certified fit to work by medical specialist recognised by Government of Malaysia.
- 8. Licence that has been suspended may be recommissioned subject to discretion of the Port Authority.
- 9. Licence may be permanently suspended if there is fraudulent identified in any documentation submitted by the pilot for application, revalidation or upgrading of his/her licence.
- 10. All pilot shall undergo following courses as required;

a. Bridge Resource Management
 b. Tanker familiarisation
 c. ISPS Code
 d. IMDG Code
 e. Marine Insurance / P&I Club
 f. Certificate of Competency Refreshment
 - Every 3 years
 - Every 3 years
 - Every 3 years
 - Every 3 years
 - As per validity

- g. Participation in a Full Mission Ship Simulation for any new build berthing facility.
- 11. Familiarization training at other ports may be recognized as a training movement if the training is conducted and certified by Marine Manager or Senior Pilot holding UR license or equivalent of the port which training is conducted.
